One of the architects of modern India was born on 17th October 1817 in Delhi.

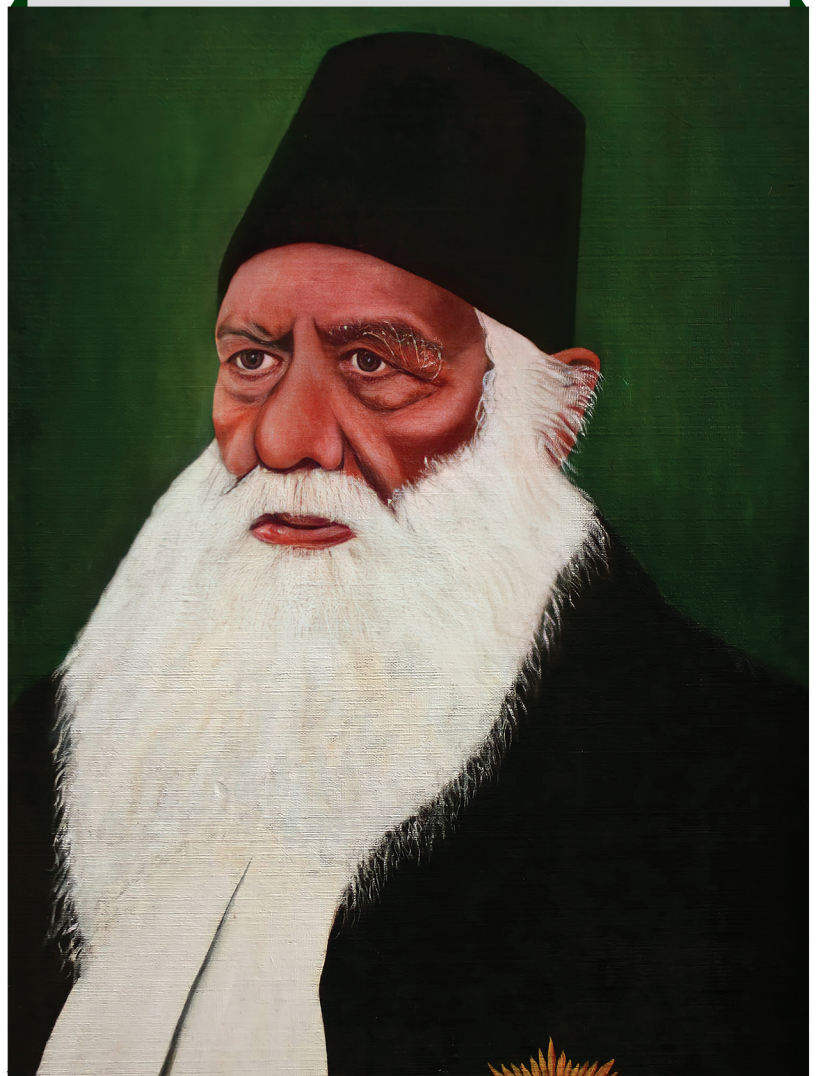
He was one of those early pioneers who recognized the critical role of education in the empowerment of the poor and backward community.

He began to prepare the road map for the formation of a Muslim University by starting various schools.

He instituted scientific society in 1863 to instill a scientific temperament into the Muslims and to make the Western knowledge available to Indians in their own language.

He died on 27th March 1898 and lies buried next to the main mosque at Aligarh Muslim University.

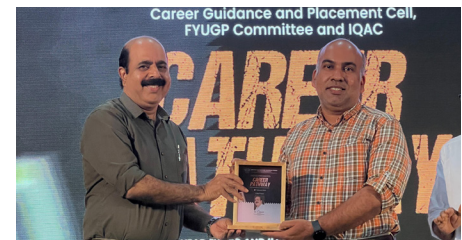

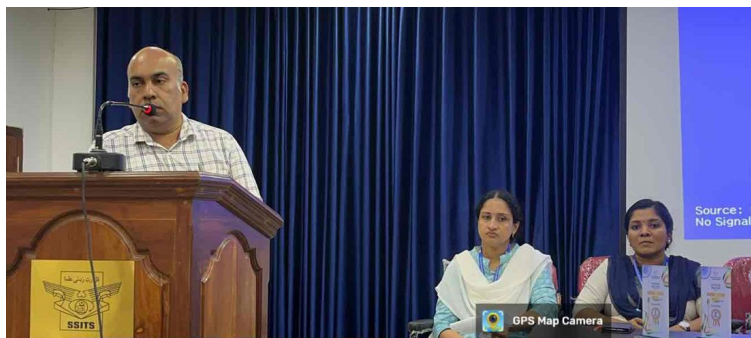
